TEACCH SCHOOL TRANSITION TO EMPLOYMENT AND POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION

The T-STEP is a *FREE* intervention developed to support transition to employment and post secondary education for 17-21 year olds with Autism Spectrum Disorder who will or have received the Future-Ready Core high school diploma.

T-STEP Program covers several transition skills grouped into the intervention:

- **Goal Setting Skills**

Choosing & Working Towards Individual Goals

- **Executive Function Skills**

Approaching Tasks in Organized Manner and Time Management & Flexibility

- **Emotion Regulation Skills**

Coping with Stress and Accepting Corrective Feedback

- **Social Skills for College & Work**
