

The T-STEP is a FREE intervention developed to support transition to employment and post secondary education for 16-21 year olds with Autism Spectrum Disorder who will or have received the Future-Ready Core high school diploma.

T-STEP Program covers several transition skills grouped into the intervention:

- Goal Setting Skills
 Choosing & Working Towards Individual Goals
- Executive Function Skills
 Approaching Tasks in Organized Manner and Time Management & Flexibility
- Emotion Regulation Skills
 Coping with Stress and Accepting Corrective Feedback
- Social Skills for College & Work
 Getting Help When Needed and Social Skills
