At Greensboro TEACCH, we provide intervention services for children and adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder and their families utilizing the strategies of Structured TEACCHing. Sessions for school-age children involve parent coaching and adult sessions can be attended independently or involve family members. All sessions are individualized to address the individual's/family's unique goals and typically occur once weekly for up to 12-15 weeks. Potential goal areas may include:
