TEACCH School Transition to Employment and Post-secondary Education

T-STEP covers transition skills in the following areas:

- Goal Setting
- Executive Function
- Emotion Regulation
- Social Skills for College and Work
- Self-Advocacy
- Career Exploration
- Post-secondary Exploration

Eligible 16-21 year old students must:

- Have a diagnosis of autism
- Be enrolled in high school or college
- Be able to access college-level materials
- *Priority for students in the Wilmington and Greenville areas, with hybrid participation options for Greenville*
- *Students outside of Eastern NC can request to join our summer virtual waitlist*

The T-STEP Program is a FREE, evidence-based college class to help autistic students transition to adulthood.
